The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) made on
14th March, 2024 between Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of
Farming Society, Kota and Government College Hisar.

About Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society, Kota:

Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society is an autonomous research and educational organization registered under 'The Rajasthan Societies Registration Act No. 28, 1958 bearing the Registration No. COOP/2023/KOTA/20108, also registered under MSME, NITI AAYOG, Govt. of India. Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society serves as a spiracle between a network of rural communities in India and other stakeholders, such as the government, development Organizations, and corporate entities. It is a spherical Organization of professionals in the agricultural and related sectors in India. By putting all of them on a single platform, AFTEFS accomplishes this task. Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society is a common platform of Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Ph.D. Scholars, Students; mystics, experts, researchers working in various scientific institutions across India and abroad, which is committed to multifaceted efforts for versatile development in the agriculture sector of India.

Government College Hisar:

Government College, Hisar is a premier higher education institution of Government of Haryana. It is a prestigious college established in 1950 and has continuously been maintaining its heritage of providing quality education to students since then. It is 'B+' grade NAAC accredited HEI and is among the Model Colleges of Government of Haryana. It is an affiliated college and recognized by UGC under sections 2(f) and 12(B). Presently, it is affiliated to Guru Jambheshwar University of Science & Technology, Hisar. It is running from a sprawling campus of about thirty-four acres with a built up area of about 9575.99 square meters. It is situated at the central location of Hisar on Rajgarh Road. It imparts learning to about 5200 students from diverse socio-cultural background in twenty-three courses for eleven undergraduate programmes including four honours and six postgraduate programmes. A dedicated, scholarly and hardworking team of about two hundred teachers assisted by committed and industrious sixty members of non teaching staff is the mainstay of the college.

The spacious classrooms with necessary teaching aids and the good network of well equipped laboratories are instrumental in imparting quality education to students. There is a separate block of Library within the main building consisting of well stocked two storied book space, a well equipped E-Resource Center and an extended reading lounge. The large eight acre multipurpose sport ground, the grounds for handball, basketball and badminton, the open gym and the facility of wrestling and boxing mats are the part of college sports infrastructure. The well furnished auditorium with good audio-visual facility provides ready arrangements for organization and rehearsal of different events. Other support facilities in the college include a well equipped Conference-cum-Activity Room, two permanent open stages, a Girls' Hostel with the facility of mess, gym and recreational room and a modest Canteen.

Government College, Hisar works as a strong powerhouse to instill in students profound academic and interpersonal skills and infuse in them intense positive energy so that they will join the bandwagon of progress and prosperity later in their career and prove themselves as real assets for the society.

PREAMBLE

Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society, Kota and Government College Hisar ,recognizing the mutual interest in the field of research, development, education and dissemination to promote joint research activities.Both Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society, Kota and Government College Hisar are joining hands to play an effective role as committed to facilitate Society-Academia Interaction activities by way of joint organization of Workshops cum Training Programs, Symposia,Conferences, Seminars, Summer & Winter Schools, Faculty Development Programs and internship work etc. in the area of their mutual interest and benefits.

NOW THEREFORE PURSUANT THERETO, both the Parties hereby agree as follows: -

The purpose of the co-operation between Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society, Kota and Government College Hisar under this MoU are as follows:

- a. to promote interest in the research and training activities of the respective institutions and
- b. Both the organizations shall seek to promote:
 - i. Organize symposia, conferences, seminar and workshops on research issues;
 - ii. Conducting joint training programs related various aspects of design, biotechnology, veterinary science, agriculture, and sciences.
 - iii. Joint research and continuing Summer & Winter Schools.
 - iv. Collaboration in research and development, and consultancy studies in the field of mutual interest

- v. Publication of academic materials and publications
- vi. Conducting expert/ guest lecturers
- vii. Undertaking joint research
- viii. Attachment of staff for purposes of curriculum development and review, attendance of courses, upgrading of teaching and research skills
- ix. Participation in seminars, symposiums, and other types of academic discussions
- x. Conducting Study tours.
- xi. Any other activity decided by mutual agreement.

A specific plan will be worked out for each activity; setting forth detailed arrangements for collaboration will be agreed. Terms and conditions for each visit or an assignment or such exchange, including those concerning financial implications will be worked out between the institutes. A separate agreement will be entered into giving such details including term of exchange of any intellectual property.

Coordination: Each institution shall designate a coordinator to oversee and facilitate the implementation of this Agreement as under. Both the coordinators will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two institutions. For this purpose, the President, Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society, Kotais **Dr. Jitendra Mehta**, and for Government College Hisar **Dr. Satish Verma**, Assistant Professor.



Commencement and Tenure of MOU

1. This Memorandum of understanding will take effect on the date of signature by both the parties herein. It shall remain in force initially for a period of five years and can be amended/ terminated on mutual written agreement between **Agriculture Forum for Technical Education of Farming Society**, Kota and **Government College Hisar**. This general agreement of cooperation shall be identified as the **parent document** of any program agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any program shall provide details concerning the **specific commitments** made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing and executed by the duly authorized representatives of the parties. Except as may be stipulated in any specific program agreement, each institution shall be responsible for expenses incurred by its employees under this agreement. Before planning any joint activity, financial responsibilities of each party shall be reduced in writing and agreed upon.
2. If a dispute arises out of or in connection with this contract/ agreement, or in respect of any defined legal relationship associated herewith or derived there from, the parties agree either to seek an amicable settlement or that dispute by conciliation under the ICADR Conciliation Rules, 1996 or to submit that dispute to arbitration under the ICADR Arbitration Rules, 1996.


3. The authority to appoint Conciliator/ Arbitrator shall be the International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution.
4. The International Centre for Alternative Dispute Resolution will provide administrative service in accordance with the ICADR Conciliation/ Arbitration Rules, 1996.
5. The place of conciliation/ arbitration proceedings shall be Kota.
6. For legal matters, the jurisdiction will be the courts at Jaipur and the Apex court.

The two parties agree with the terms and conditions specified as above, put their signature, and seal witness of the same.


